I. Statistics of the 20th ENS Meeting in Berlin

The statistics of the total number of abstracts submitted (842) to the Scientific Committee of the Twentieth Meeting of the European Neurological Society, which took place at the International Congress Centrum (ICC) on 19-23 June 2010, in Berlin, Germany, have been evaluated, and are given below.

The bar-chart of Fig. 1. illustrates the number of abstracts submitted according to each topic dealt with at the 20th ENS meeting. Concerning the number of abstracts accepted, the pie-chart of Fig. 2. gives the distribution by which those abstracts selected by the Scientific Committee were presented at the congress in Berlin; as poster or oral presentations. The graphic of Fig. 3. presents ten countries with the highest number of participants out of a total number of 83 countries worldwide. [More »](#)
